POSITION DESCRIPTION

Main Street Launch is seeking a full time data and online content manager. This critical role will help support an informed and data-driven approach to economic development and neighborhood stabilization. This position will support the work of business outreach managers working in San Francisco and Oakland to develop and manage two online merchant directories for San Francisco Chinatown and Oakland. This position will be responsible for the day-to-day management of each merchant directory websites, as well as managing all data in salesforce.

In addition to managing the public facing merchant directory data, this position will also support a data-driven approach to economic development by helping generate data and content for internal and external presentations. This will include mapping economic development indicators collected by Business Outreach Managers, as well as researching 3rd party data sources that can enrich our work and help Main Street Launch better understand economic development in Oakland and San Francisco.

Marketing & Business Directory

Main Street Launch is in the process of developing 2 online merchant directories for San Francisco's Chinatown and Oakland. These two directories are independent websites. This position will be responsible for the functioning of these sites, the accuracy of content, and developing approaches for marketing each site to consumers. Each site is built on a WordPress platform and all data must be backed up through in Salesforce.

Vacancy Tracking

Business Outreach Managers will be noting vacancies as they are out in the field that will be tracked in Salesforce. The Data and Online Content Manager will create, update and manage a web app through ArcGIS online. The goal is to generate a user-friendly web app that will allow prospective entrepreneurs to find spaces to conduct business.

Position Responsibilities:

- Managing Salesforce data base of business content to ensure accuracy of data across all online platforms
- Write and edit online business descriptions
- Manage website content to ensure business owners have accurate and appealing descriptions that will help drive new customer acquisition
- Support Business Outreach Managers in data collection as needed
- Map data using ArcGIS to track vacancies and other business patterns, generate reports, and present data analysis to inform decision-making
- Support the development team through data collection and research, and through maintaining the data infrastructure used for fundraising and impact reporting needs.
